Activity day 1:

From 8:00am to 4:30pm: Cave Tubing/Zip Lining with Lunch

Cave Tubing is an activity very specific to Belize. It is a stroll in a creek where you sit on a tube and are transported by the current, guided by a professional. But before you will walk around 30 minutes through the jungle alongside the river. During one hour, you will pass under dark caves and their wonderful cavities that you will discover thanks to your headlamps. These caves are called "Xibalba" that means "Mayan hell", it is a real underground world.

After tubing, head back to the parking lot to change into dry clothing then head over to the nearby ziplines. After getting geared up in your harness and helmet, ride six or seven different ziplines through the rainforest canopy. Soar across the same river that you floated through during your cave tubing experience. Your tour ends with a drop-off back where you started.

Activity day 2:

From 9:00am to 2:00pm: Barton Creek Cave and Big Rock Falls with Lunch, through San Miguel

Barton Creek Cave is a wet natural cave in Mountain Pine Ridge. The cave offers a canoeing adventure into the Maya underworld. This cave is considered one of Belize's most fascinating natural and cultural wonders and used by the Ancient Maya people for ceremonial purposes. The journey to the cave brings you through the Mennonite Community of Upper and Lower Barton Creek, and you might be able to observe their traditional lifestyle from afar. The trip leads along an intense and bumpy dirt road and includes crossing a shallow creek.

The surroundings of the cave are lush tropical landscapes. You will enter via canoe and travel around one mile along a twisty river deeper in the cave, flowing through the vast and beautiful cathedral-like chambers of the cavern.

This tour also visits Big Rock Falls. Tucked into the Mountain Pine Ridge Forest Reserve this waterfall prompts your jaw to drop once you lay eyes upon it. After numerous wooden stairways plunging into the forest, you will arrive at the bottom where the 150-foot waterfall stands. You can choose to have lunch before or after heading down to the water's edge to relax before heading back from the day's tour.

- River Cruise & Baboon Sanctuary Tour

Cruise along the Belize River to The Community Baboon Sanctuary (CBS) which is a pioneering project in voluntary grassroots conservation. It is home to The Black Howler Monkey which is the largest monkey in the Americas, and found only in a small section of Central America. The goal of the sanctuary is to sustain the habitat of the Black Howler Monkey (called ‘baboon’ in the local Creole dialect) while promoting the economic development of the participating communities. The result has been an innovative project in sustainable ecotourism that protects the habitat for the endangered Black Howler Monkey and other species while offering a unique opportunity for visitors to experience the rainforest and witness Black Howler Monkeys in the wild.

Over 200 private landowners in seven villages, stretching over 20 square miles, have voluntarily pledged to conserve their land for the protection of the Black Howler Monkey habitat. Many of these landowners benefit directly from the Sanctuary thanks to ecotourism. Many more benefit indirectly through the educational programs. Cahal Pech "Place of Ticks" in Yucatek Maya, is a noteworthy archaeological zone located within the upper Belize River Valley in the town of San Ignacio. Its original name may have been K'an Hix, "Yellow Jaguar", or alternatively the name of the ruling dynastic lineage. The site is situated on the ridge of a high hill overlooking the Macal River. This vantage point allowed the site to control not only the trade on the river, but the rich, fertile valley to the north. It is located about 6 miles/10 km northeast from the important site of Xunantunich. Xunantunich, "Maiden of the Rock/Stone Woman", is a Classic Maya (200-900 CE) archaeological zone located in the western part of Belize along the border with Guatemala. It is situated on a high ridge overlooking the Mopan River. This strategic location allowed for the control of trade along this important river, and through the adjoining valley. San Ignacio Market Day at the San Ignacio Farmer's Market is one of the most anticipated days of the week for local farmers, vendors and visitors. Although the market in San Ignacio is open every day of the week, Saturdays are the locally designated day as "market day." In just one location, all walks of Belizean life come together to trade and sell their fresh produce or goods.

Saturday: Barrier Reef Snorkeling/Easy

Majority of the snorkeling takes place a short 35 minutes away in the South Water Caye Marine Reserve where conservation and safety are the key words. All trips are accompanied by a certified Belizean Tour guide who would love to share his passion and knowledge of the ocean with you. The weather influences our choice of snorkeling sites. When we snorkel the northern part of the Southern Barrier Reef, we usually make a stop at Man-of-War Caye where there are a variety of nesting birds like frigates and brown boobies. On this trip entry and exit are directly from the boat, as opposed to the island based snorkeling where you can wade into the water from the beach. This trip is ideal for agile and experienced snorkelers as snorkeling is done from the boat. For less confident or new snorkelers, we can drop the snorkel teams off at an island where you can relax, explore the island or simply snorkel in the waters from the beach

Sunday: Jungle River Canoeing/Easy

From its origin deep within the Maya Mountains the Sittee River snakes its way to the sea with its mouth just south of Hopkins. The trip starts near the Creole village of Sittee River and slowly heads towards the ocean.

You will have fun spotting green and orange iguanas lounging in trees and maybe a crocodile resting at the water's edge. Parrots, toucans, motmots, herons and egrets often can be seen and heard! There have been sightings of stingrays, manatee and crocodiles far upriver. As you get closer to the sea the dense jungle gives way to large mangrove forests.

You will then go on a two-minute walk where you will be provided with inner tubes to float down the Stann Creek River and feel the refreshing water while listening to the tranquil sounds of the jungle, accompanied by a guide who will point out the flora and fauna as you go along.

Cruise along the Belize River to The Community Baboon Sanctuary (CBS) which is a pioneering project in voluntary grassroots conservation. It is home to The Black Howler Monkey which is the largest monkey in the Americas, and found only in a small section of Central America. The goal of the sanctuary is to sustain the habitat of the Black Howler Monkey (called 'baboon' in the local Creole dialect) while promoting the economic development of the participating communities. The result has been an innovative project in sustainable ecotourism that protects the habitat for the endangered Black Howler Monkey and other species while offering a unique opportunity for visitors to experience the rainforest and witness Black Howler Monkeys in the wild.

Over 200 private landowners in seven villages, stretching over 20 square miles, have voluntarily pledged to conserve their land for the protection of the Black Howler Monkey habitat. Many of these landowners benefit directly from the Sanctuary thanks to ecotourism. Many more benefit indirectly through the educational programs. Moreover, the population of the Black Howler Monkey in the Sanctuary has risen to over 2,000 monkeys. Bring your camera because the monkeys love to be photographed.

- Cave Tubing & Zipline

Cave Tubing is an activity very specific to Belize. It is a stroll in a creek where you sit on a tube and are transported by the current, guided by a professional. But before you will walk around 30 minutes through the jungle alongside the river. During one hour, you will pass under dark caves and their wonderful cavities that you will discover thanks to your headlamps. These caves are called "Xibalba" that means "Mayan hell", it is a real underground world.

After tubing, head back to the parking lot to change into dry clothing then head over to the nearby ziplines. After getting geared up in your harness and helmet, ride six or seven different ziplines through the rainforest canopy. Soar across the same river that you floated through during your cave tubing experience. Your tour ends with a drop-off back where you started.
